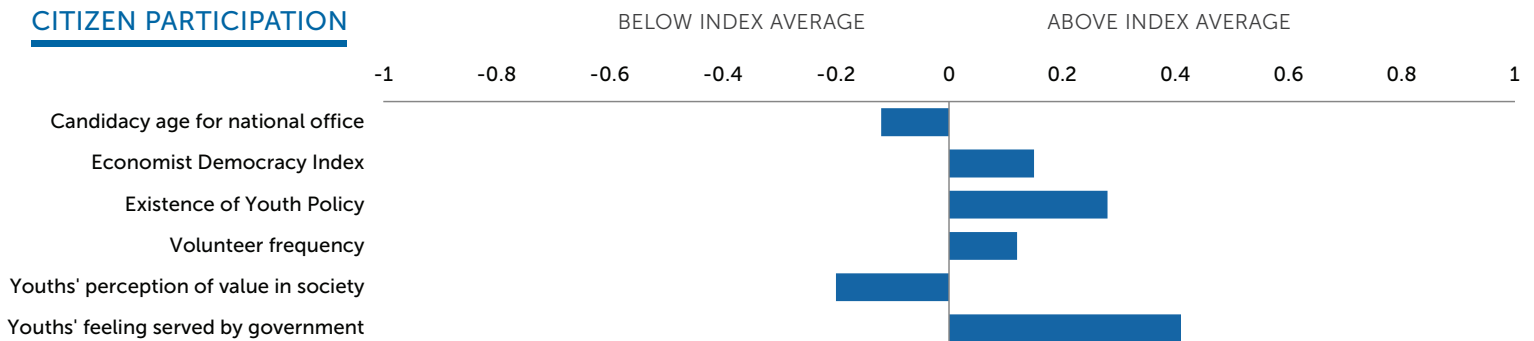

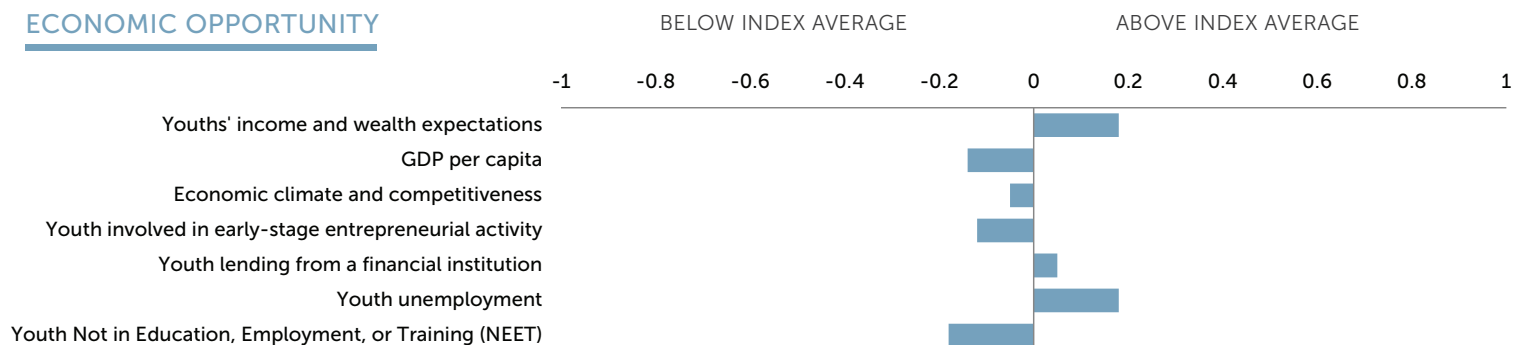

AT 26TH, INDIA is the lowest ranked country in the Asia-Pacific region and the second to last country in the lower-middle income bracket, followed only by Nigeria. India does poorly across domains with the exception of citizen participation, where India excels in 3rd place and is the highest ranking Asia-Pacific and lower-middle income country. Youths' perceptions are generally aligned with the realities they face.
