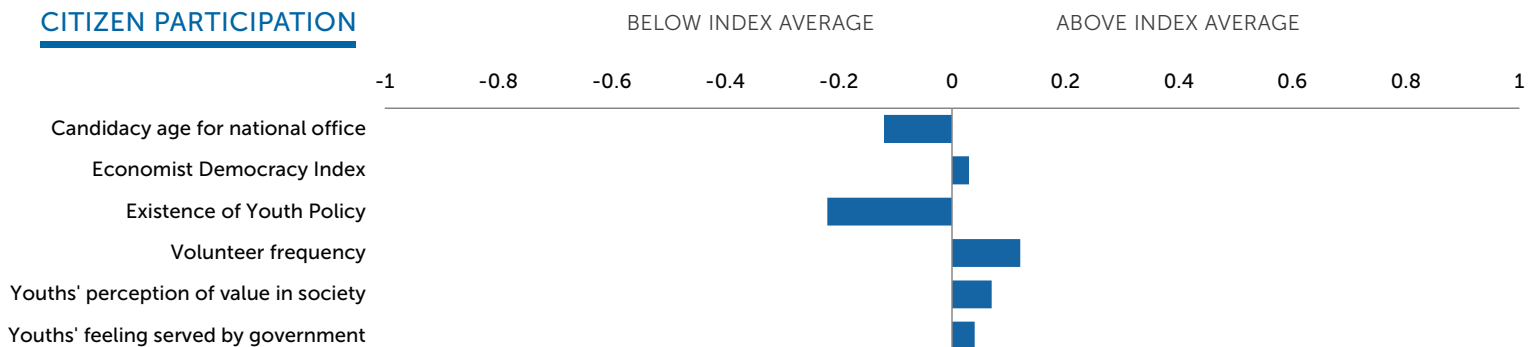

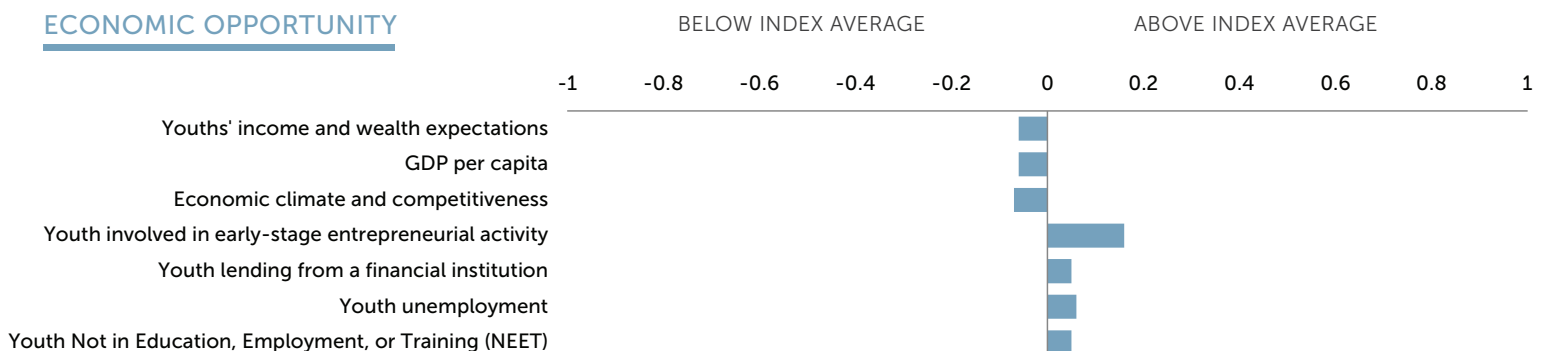

AT 12TH PLACE, PERU ranks second of the five countries in the Americas region, behind the United States. Peru also comes in second among the upper-middle income countries behind Thailand, and places in the second of four tiers of youth wellbeing. Peru's highest rankings are in the safety and security and ICT domains. Peru also comes in second in citizen participation and health, but their outlook is more negative in economic opportunity and safety and security.
